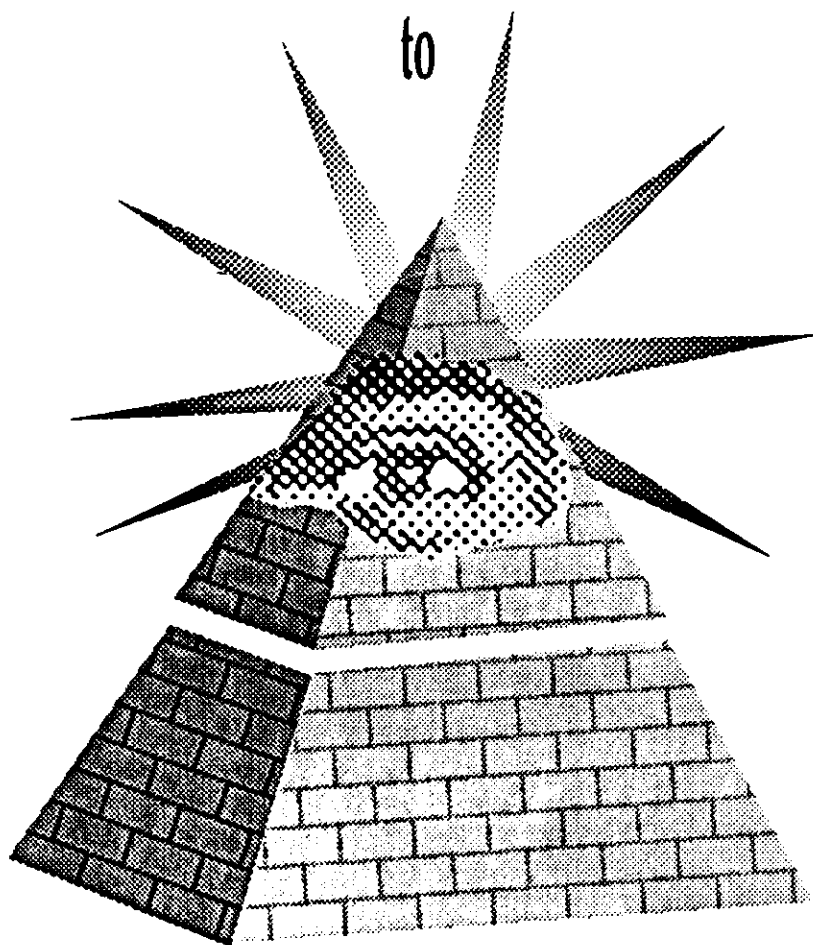

WINTER STAR 1992 Symposium

Robert Anton Wilson is an author, editor, lecturer and guerrilla ontologist with an avid interest in human behavior. He presents **Quantum Psychology, How Brain Software Programs You and Your Universe**. While conventional wisdom holds that quantum uncertainty only exists on the sub-atomic level, and that "we still live in a Newtonian Universe", this seminar demonstrates that all the mysteries of the quantum world can be seen in modern brain science. Looking at the "soft sciences" of sociology and perception psychology, and the "hard sciences" of quantum mechanics and cosmology, Wilson demonstrates that "Whatever we talk about, the human mind must appear in our model, or we talk nonsense."

Robert Shea has been a full time magazine writer, editor and novelist for over 20 years. His interest in mysticism is evident throughout his work. His novels include **Shike, All Things Are Lights**, and **The Saracen**. His most recent novel is **Shaman**, about a Native American Medicine Man caught up in the Black Hawk War of 1832. His talk is **Writing and Mysticism**. For Shea, mysticism means "direct, intuitive experience of ultimate reality (however the seeker understands that), together with the practices leading to that experience and the outlook the experience engenders." He'll explore ways that the study of mysticism can help writers tap their creative potential and free themselves from the inhibiting "lust for result".

The Reverend Ivan Stang is Sacred Scribe and main disorganizer of the Church of the SubGenius. He is an author, film producer, clay animator and genuine crackpotologist. The Most Holy and Orthodox Czar Reverend Stang disseminates the SLACK-gospel of "Bob" through his weekly, nationally syndicated Hour of Slack Radio Show. His rant is a Special, War of the Sexes, pull the lever down you go, Subgenius Devival with Mondo Connie. See hitherto perfectly respectable Pagans praising "Bob", and what the hell, many the nearest SubGenius in a real-live, short-term wedding. Shut-up or stand up!

Patricia Monaghan is the author of the classic dictionary of feminine divinities, **The Book of Goddesses and Heroines**. Two new books are due during 1992: **Seasons of the Witch**, a collection of Pagan Poems; and **Daughters of the Cauldron**, Goddess stories for children. Her workshops: **Pagan Utopias**--You'd live close to nature in polygamous perversity? You'd live under a weather dome on the moon? Pagans imagine creating a new world, but the new worlds of their dreams are often quite diverse. In this game-filled workshop, participants build and share their own utopias. Come prepared for discussion and dissent! **Spiritual Writing**--Translating spiritual experience into words is often difficult. The most moving experience can be diminished by ineffective expression. In this hands-on workshop, you'll learn techniques for more effectively expressing your inner realities.

Andras Corban Arthan is a nationally recognized Wiccan Leader and Teacher, Folk singer, director of EarthSpirit Communities in Boston, publisher of **FireHeart Magazine**, and author of the forthcoming book, **Between the Worlds: Witchcraft, Shamanism and The Magical Reality**. His talk is entitled **Modern Witchcraft and Shamanism**.

Donna Boswell, Ohio Licensed Masso-therapist, will speak on **Future Medicine: Alpha Stim**. She will demonstrate the benefits of combining massage techniques and Micro Amperage electro stim in healing chronic and acute soft tissue injuries. She will be available during WinterStar for consultation and treatment.

Kenneth Delgh is an internationally recognized lecturer, creative director of N'Chi Esoteric Publishing, and founder of the Sheya System of Magick, will present **On Invocation and Evocation of God-forms, Goddesses, and Spirits of the Night**. This workshop discusses the theory and practice of invocation and evocation and their differences: the various techniques of summoning non-ordinary entities into your sacred space - and into yourself. Includes demonstration and practical application.

Ian Corrigan, bard, author of the **Book of the Dragon**, lecturer and magician/priest is founder of The Open Circle and Liturgist for Stone Creed Grove ADF. His workshop is **Sacred Fire and Holy Well: Practical Approaches to Celtic Magic and Religion**. His audio tape, **Cosmology of Wizardry** is available from A.C.E., as are his musical tapes, **Once Around the Wheel** and **Songs of the Wheel**.

Ariana Lightningstorm is the leader of an unusual musical ensemble, **KIVA**, a band dedicated to bringing the spirit of magic back to the art of music. Their musical styles come from all over the world, including folk, blues, traditional and jazz. We're delighted to have Ariana and KIVA with us. If you have a drum (it's not required), you'll want to bring it to Ariana's workshop, **Healing Through Sound, Music, and Chanting**.

Colleen Clark holds a BFA in Dance from Ohio State University and is on the faculty of Cleveland State University's Dance Program. She is a performer, choreographer, and teacher.

Karen Allgire holds an MFA in Dance from Case Western Reserve University. Her expertise in dance and choreography is evident in the past several years' Starwood Bonfire Lighting Ceremonies. She will assist Colleen in her workshop **Contact Improvisation**, an exhilarating movement form which helps release the body and access the intuition. It's an art/sport involving individuals moving together by sharing weight and maintaining continuous physical contact.

Joseph Rothenberg is a Registered Nurse, licensed professional counselor, A.C.E. co-founder and consultant in biofeedback, mind entrainment devices and sensory isolation. His mind machines, including the **Neuro-Pop**, will be set up for you to experience throughout the symposium.

Ric Campbell has been a practitioner of the healing arts for over 15 years and specializes in holistic healing and massage. His workshop is **Psychic Massage**; learn to heal yourself and other by opening yourself fully to the powers that surround you. Ric will teach you to remove the energy blocks caused by stress, abuse and fear, through a healing system of touch, thought and love. Bring a towel.

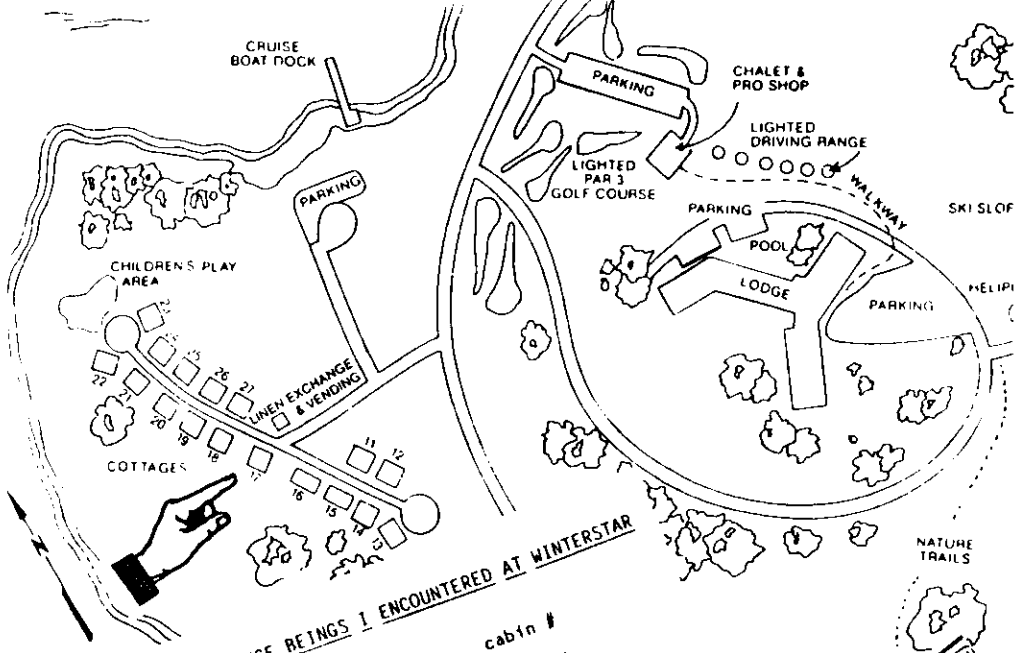

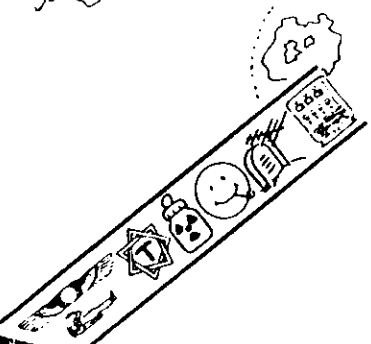

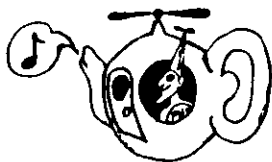
